2023 Rally schedule Deferred to next meeting

GTA rally related to the Woodward Dream Cruise – question is about a different format, offer free entry? "GTA" stands for Game, Tour, and Adventure. This type of rally, also known as a "gimmick" or "game" rally, is typically a contest run in cars on public roads, with a driver and a co-driver (navigator). The primary method of scoring is by other than the Time-Speed-Distance (TSD) format used in other SCCA road rallies. Question and Answer GTA rallies feature scoring determined by answering questions posed by the rallymaster as teams follow the rally course. Usually the answers to the questions are determined from signs or landmarks along the route. Occasionally, questions from "general knowledge" are used, usually relating to the theme of the event ("Name Santa's reindeer" in a Christmas rally). The questions can range from very easy ("What Street are you on?") to much more difficult ("Who was the 24th president of the United States")?
