Club Racing Specialty Meeting

- Worker of the Year Award
 - One per division need nominations
 - Can be any specialty
 - Nomination form is on the website
 - Deadline for submission is August 1st
 - Division Administrator and Regional Executives vote

 - o Updates this year are for Flagging & Communications and Emergency Services

Majors - National Program

- Piloting in 2012
 - Current product is stale
 - is of little interest to younger demographics
 - other groups siphoning off drivers and workers
 - multiclass racing is not desired by racers
 - Proliferation of Nationals and Rationals dilutes the number of participants in single events
 - o Current program has little marketing opportunities
 - This is an opt in program
 - The intent is to cluster the competition and provide a better experience for everyone
 - o National office will provide a 'tool kit' for best practices
 - A Zone will consist of combined Divisions
 - Midwest, Rocky Mountain, and Southwest will be testing this year
 - Will be comprised of six weekends, two per Division (one Invitational and one Showcase each)
 - Invitational event
 - Comprised of top ten classes within a Zone representing 70% of entries at previous National SCCA events
 - On track two or three times each day for no less than 20 minutes each
 - Showcase event
 - Comprised nineteen classes not included in the Invitational representing 30% of entries at previous National SCCA events
 - Split starts
