

## **SCCA – Detroit Region 2019 Road Rally Championship**

---

### **Rules and Eligibility**

The competition season shall be the calendar year 2019.

Competitors must be full-time members of the Detroit Region SCCA (not a “weekend membership”) at the last rally of the year to earn competition points for that season.

Individuals will be scored for their best four finishes in a seven rally year for class championship points. (General rules: 3 of 4, 3 of 5, 4 of 6, 4 of 7, 5 of 8, etc.)

All finishes in all classes will be counted for the overall championship. (See limitation below)

Championship trophies will be awarded in Equipped, Limited, and Stock classes as defined in the 2019 SCCA Road Rally Rules.

Vintage class will be combined with Limited class for championship points.

Novice class will be combined with Stock class for championship points.

Eligible entrants will earn points based on finishing position in class. Points will be awarded following the National Rally Championship schedule (10, 8, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1.9, 1.8, etc).

Rally chairman and assistant chairman (one of each per event) will be awarded points equal to their highest finish in competition in other DR SCCA rallies. The class in which these points will be awarded must be declared on the results list submitted to the Rally Director. If no declaration is made, these points will be awarded in the first class competed in during the year. Rally chairmen and assistant chairmen may earn organizer points for a maximum of one event per year. Press on Regardless will be scored as two separate events.

All competitors in all classes must work at least one DR SCCA Road Rally competition event each year in order to be considered for class or overall championship position. For example, serving as a control crew for a full event or full day (whichever is less), or running pre-check or sweep will fulfill this requirement. Rally chairmen (including Rally School) and assistant chairmen fulfill the work requirement by putting on their event. Other types of “work” credit must be proposed prior to the event by the event chairman.
