## Notes on results:

Trophies were awarded to first in class.

Leg 4 was not scored as the control crew did not record the 1/100 minutes for the first few competitors.

All the results were calculated to 15 decimal places. For the fast speeds, this doesn't make any difference. For those of you in the slower speed class, the numbers are kept in the computer to the 15 places and the total reflects the sum of these numbers rounded. For this reason, if you add your individual leg scores, you may find a point or two difference from the total. I assure you that the total is correct.
