The 1999 Central Division Road Rally Tour returned to Michigan for the third running of the Grand Adventure Tour Rally. The event was again co-hosted by the West Michigan and Detroit Regions of SCCA, and counted for points in both the Detroit Region and CENDIV Rally Championships.

This year the event moved west to the Lake Michigan shoreline and ran along the Kalamazoo River, Thanks to heavy rainfall a few days preceding the rally and the county road graders most of the roads were smooth and relatively well groomed.

The day was perfect with 65 degrees and sunshine as 21 cars took to the mid afternoon start.

At the break there was a three-way tie for first overall between the Harvey /Mickle Eagle, Parps/Moran GalantVR-4 and G.Henderson/Martin in their Subaru.

The one car that did not arrive to the halfway point was the novice team of Boer/Bos, seems that a plaguing clutch problem finally gave out altogether, leaving the Mazda 323 stranded with a 'box of neutrals, fortunately. A control team happened upon them and brought them back to the halfway stop, where another worker helped to rescue the car.

Although the remaining 20 teams made the finish, a couple of them forgot their course following priorities and did stray off course, missing a control or two. Of the 16 controls, 14 were scored, one thrown because the scoring clock stopped working entirely just as the 1st car was just due to arrive.

Jim Fekete/Jim Shaffer first in Limited and the beautifully prepared 1964 MGB of Eric Jones/ Harry Ward best in vintage class, Rich Warden/Rick Robinette repeated as stock class champions in their Saab 900. First place Novice went To Adam Speiszney/Wojciech Dlugoszwski in a Nissan 240SX, they just edged out the team of Arnaud Guibout/ Arnaud Leroux, a pair visiting from France competing in their hosts Ford Taurus. Honorable mention goes out to the father and son team of Harkcum/Harkcum, co-driver Dan (the son) is but 15 years old, yet with only 21 points he already knows his way around the computer better than a lot of us veterans.
