The 2001 edition of the CAST In Stone rally was run on June 9th, 2001. There were two new aspects of the rally – this was the first year that the rally was run as a national and located "up north" in Michigan's lower peninsula. Numerous roads made famous from previous rallies were supposed to be used as the route started from West Branch and made one long clockwise loop around Houghton Lake to finish back at West Branch. Unfortunately, the weather wreaked some havoc on the course. Two to three weeks of consistent heavy rain wiped out the roads on which the first six checkpoints (which included several of the most famous roads noted above) and one checkpoint about halfway into the rally were located. Scattered heavy showers also visited the area the day of the event which made the passable roads more challenging (and they were plenty challenging when dry). Out of 30 planned checkpoints, 23 were scored.

There was a tie for first place in equipped class and overall in both the divisional and national classifications. Since no tie-breaking procedure was established in the general instructions, the tie was not broken. The teams of Ron Johnstonbaugh/Jack von Kaenel and Ken Knight/Greg Lester had a total of 18 points for the 23 scored controls. Scott Harvey/Jim Mickle placed third with 23 points. Dan Coughnour/Joe Andreini placed fourth with 25 points. Competition was very tight in the equipped class and plentiful

with nine divisional teams and eight of them running as national as well.

There were four divisional stock entries with two them running as national. Richard Worden and Richard Robinette took first place in Divisional and National with 99 points.

Julie and Charles Hanson finsihed second in Divisional and National with 218 points.

There were four novice divisional entries as well. Bill Clawson and Tom Corey won novice class with 576 points. Zachary Branigan and Nat Delafield finished second in novice class with 1181 points.
