


Timing Input On/Off

During worker changeover, the timing input to the computer should be turned off to prevent false times being input.



When this icon shows a stoplight, timing input is off

Click it once to allow times to be input from the timing box




If there are issues with the timing lights, the timing and scoring chief will ask you to toggle this off while fixing the lights. It's critical to toggle it back on before runs start.

Entering cars into the computer

As cars stage to start their runs, enter their number and press tab. If there is only one of that number at the event, Axware will automatically fill in the class. Press tab again and that row will be complete.


If the number is being used by more than one participant (ie, more than one class) when you press tab you will need to enter the class. If you click the class box after the number, a box will appear with the available classes registered to that number. You can click the class and press tab to complete the row. Or you can just type the class in and hit tab



Entering Penalties

Cones

When you hear penalties called into control, try to add them into the computer. If you don't catch them all, no worries. To add a cone click the plus button until the number in the box represents the number of cones for the run.



If you accidentally entered a cone when none should be entered, hit the minus button.


DNFs

If the driver DNFs the run, select the DNF button.




Reruns

If a re run is called for the run, click on the box and select rrun,



The run number will be grayed out which will help with sorting how many runs that driver has done




Remember to save

Remember to save the event at least once per run, in case Axware craps out or errors start showing up. Cntrl S or file -> save.

Live Timing
