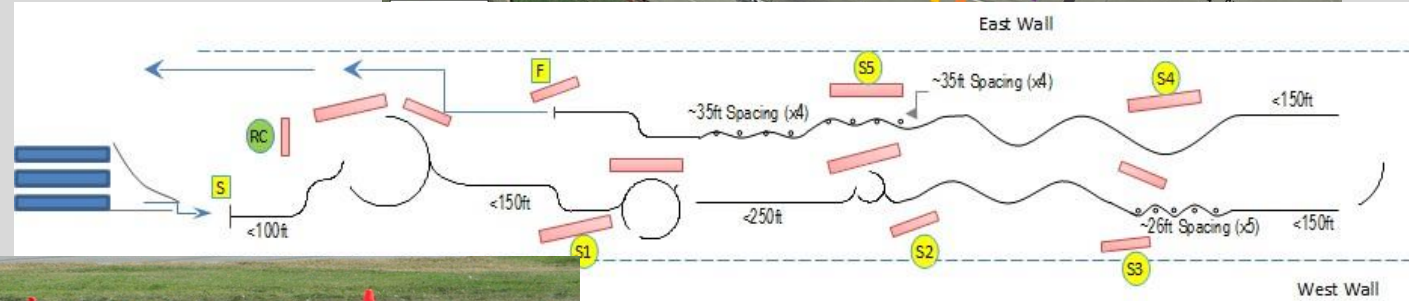




FORMULA SAE®

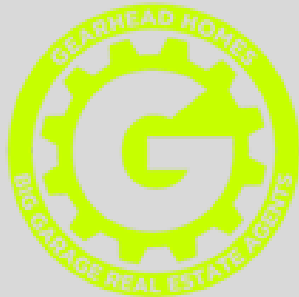
